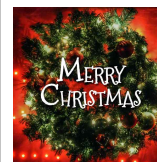

Mount Herz in Jerusalem has a memorial museum called Yad Vashem. The museum is dedicated to the Jews killed by Nazi Germany during the Word War II. The name Yad Vashem means "to remember names."
